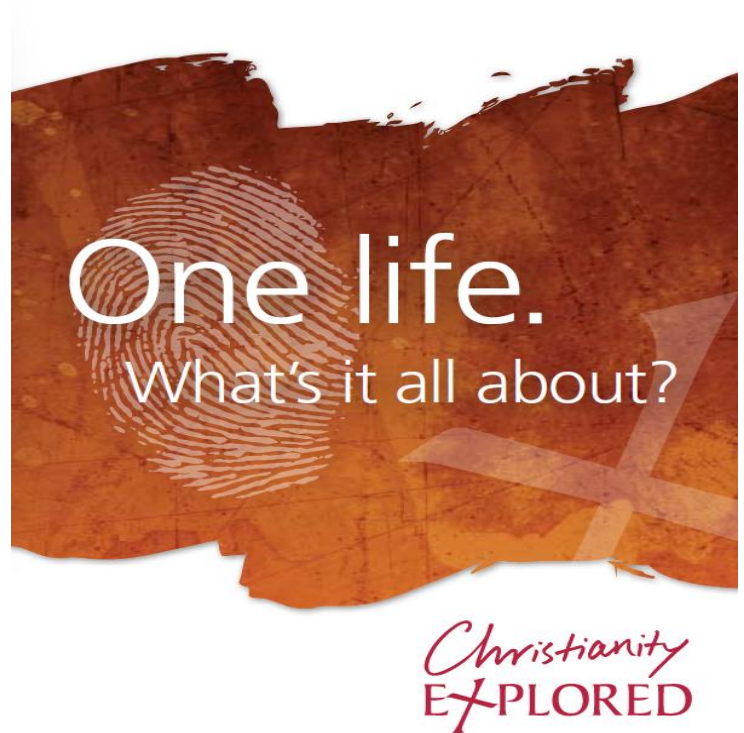
Christianity Explored will help you discover answers to many of life's questions as you explore the Gospel of Mark with others through Bible readings, talks and discussions.
